



School Fees

Georges River College Oatley Senior Campus fees have been set as follows.

School Contribution – \$50

The School Contribution fee is a voluntary fee that allows the school to provide a range of services to students and families. It covers SMS absence notification, school reports, certificates, printing, posting to parents, purchasing of paper and other services beyond those that can be funded from the School Budget allocation which mainly covers utilities and site maintenance.

Resource Levy – \$100

The Resource Levy allows the school to provide a range of services to students and families. It covers student ID card, photocopying for Year 11 and HSC courses, examinations, special events such as Presentation Day and Graduation, references, servicing of equipment in practical rooms, maintenance of outdoor learning spaces and other services beyond those that can be funded from the School Budget allocation which mainly covers utilities and site maintenance.

Textbook Hire – \$50

The textbook hire covers 1 year and is payable at the beginning of each school year. Alternatively students can purchase textbooks privately. This is not refundable.

Technology Levy - \$30

The Technology Levy allows the school to provide a range of services to students and families. It covers maintenance of equipment, ink, iPads, upgrading software and forward planning for the purchase of updated technology to allow for success in the HSC.

P & C School Support Levy – \$40

The "P & C Direct Giving" avoids further requests for financial support throughout the year. These funds are donated to the school to assist with supporting student learning by donating money for whole school programs and extra curricular activities..

Locker Hire - \$40

School lockers are available for hire at \$40 for 2 years.

Mandatory Subject Fees

These fees cover the costs of consumable items in all subjects. The school covers the cost of all textbooks and resources. It is expected that all students will meet their subject fee commitments.

Support Unit fees are paid separately. TAFE fees where applicable are paid separately.

Families at our school are asked to support the high quality education that the school provides by paying both the school contribution and the subject fees as this significantly enhances the educational experiences we are able to provide for your sons and daughters. Nearly all families pay their school fees. Senior students over 16 years experiencing financial difficulties may apply for Youth Allowance through Centrelink to assist their educational expenses or pay by instalments. All tuition and faculty costs are free in a government school.
