



My STEP TO THE FUTURE - Senior Program

My STEP (Senior Transition and Education Plan) to the Future is an alternate HSC program for students continuing their education in the senior years until the age of 17 years and beyond.

This customised program combines the study of relevant, engaging school subjects focusing on literacy and numeracy skills improvement with the acquisition of employability skills and vocational qualifications.

The program is designed to address the needs of a young person continuing their education and or entering today's labour market. These needs are:

- To be studying relevant, engaging senior subjects in which success can be experienced.
- Interpersonal skills and resilience
- Access to career exploration opportunities
- Work readiness skills and awareness of employer's expectations
- The ability to self-manage one's own career pathway
- Vocational skills and qualifications
- To be studying senior subjects appropriate to academic ability and interests.
- An individualised vocational pathway
- Assistance to make a successful transition from the middle years of schooling to the senior campus and with the demands of being a senior student.
- Positive attitude to learning at school, work or at further education
- A feature of the program is that each participant will be individually case managed by the Careers and Transition Adviser together with other specialist staff such as the Learning Support Teacher, School Counsellor and Youth Workers.

MY STEP TO THE FUTURE senior program will focus on

- Skills acquisition for future employment
- Successful transitions to further vocational study, such as TAFE
- Work readiness and employability skills
- Engagement for learning

My STEP to the Future senior program will be customised for each participant from the following components including school courses:

- HSC pathways program can be followed to accumulate the HSC over several years
- Combination of HSC study with a school-based apprenticeships or traineeships
- Certificate II Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways (TAFE Digital)
- Youth Engagement Strategy courses at local TAFE campuses.

- English Studies
- Pathways to Mathematics Standard 1
- School delivered vocational courses eg Hospitality, Construction, Business Services, Retail Services
- Externally delivered TAFE courses that are studied at TAFE Campuses eg Photography, Automotive, Early Childhood Education and Care, Beauty Services, Design Fundamentals
- The study of courses that are practically oriented and that students find relevant and engaging such as Sport Lifestyle and Recreation, Ceramics, Sport Coaching, Music
- Workplace experiences

MY STEP TO THE FUTURE senior program will provide students with

- Youth Engagement Strategy program participation
- An updated Record of Secondary Education (ROSA)
- TAFE credentials
- Employability skills
- Access to employment through specialised services
- A career pathway plan
- A relevant and engaging program of experiences
- Confidence and maturity
