Acceptable school shoes for Year 11

We are a uniform school. All students are expected to dress in uniform every day. Parents are asked to support the wearing of school inform. GRC Oatley does not have a sport uniform. Students are supplied with appropriate sport uniform when they represent the school in various knockout, regional or state events.

NSW Department of Education OHS regulations requires students to wear school shoes

1. of a leather or leather-like material (no canvas)
2. which cover the entire upper section of the foot to protect against falling objects or spilt liquids

As well, GRC Oatley Campus requires students to wear completely black shoes (including laces) with no brandings or logos.

Footwear Guidelines:-

The Department of Education through its WHS Policy, is committed to providing a safe working and learning environment for all employees, other undertaking work, students and visitors in accordance with statutory and regulatory obligations and corporate objectives.
