These BYOD Portals has been set up, in partnership with Apple Store Miranda and JB Hi Fi, to provide a one stop shop for our school community to purchase a suitable device. All devices listed meet all BYOD criteria and there is the option to purchase accessories and insurance. There is no obligation to use this portal and you are not limited to just the devices listed here. Students are free to purchase their BYOD device from whomever they choose.

The devices on this site have been chosen based on the following criteria:-

- Built to handle the rigours of a school environment.
- Capable of performing tasks required by teachers to complete educational outcomes of students.
- Compatible with the school's wireless network, software and systems.
- Have an appropriate battery life for use at school.

• Typically carry a Business-grade, 3-year Next Business Day Onsite Warranty (Most retailers only offer a return-to-base warranty).

• Represent excellent value with discounted 'Education' pricing.


• Insurance Option - All devices can include an optional Accidental Damage and Theft Protection plan.
