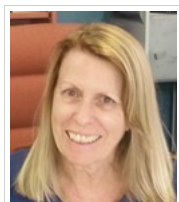

Principal's Message



Below is a great article that might help parents in guiding the children to post HSC success:

Exams aren't everything: Think Education

As school kids across the nation knuckle down in preparation for October's Year 12 exams, the executive dean of private tertiary educator Think Education is encouraging parents to get their child to consider what they want to do with their life.

Professor Helmut Lueckenhausen, said it's important families help reduce exam stress for students, but it's equally important to encourage students to consider what they want from life after school. During the exam period, young people face considerable pressure to select their career path and, Lueckenhausen said, students often choose career paths out of pressure from friends or family, or based on their exam scores, rather than following their passion.

A recent Think Education survey of 1500 people aged 18–35 revealed almost half of young workers aren't in their preferred career path. Lueckenhausen said if students don't achieve the exam results needed to follow the most direct route to their career path – it is imperative parents remind their kids that there are alternative ways of achieving goals.

"Is there any one path or are there alternative paths to that goal? If one path looks closed off, say for example a poor exam result, what is plan B? If not plan B, what is plan C and so on? Students don't need to put all of their eggs in one basket in important matters such as this," he said.

Constant reminders that there are alternatives can also reduce exam stress, Lueckenhausen said, and while some pressure is good for students – as it sharpens their focus – too much overloads them. He said the best way parents can help their students cope with exam stress is to push them to do their best but remain conscious of and considerate of their child's physical and emotional wellbeing.

"Our children don't believe us if we congratulate them without them deserving it," he said. "They just want to know that we'll be there to help them with alternatives if they need us to and that our love and our support is unconditional. I think any parent just needs to do what they've been doing well up until now."

Farewell Year 12 2015

We welcome Year 12 back on 13 November. Our Year 11 students have graduated into their HSC year from the start of term 4. For them, Year 12 began with the Year 12 Conference, a day when important information was relayed about HSC rules and requirements, assessments, being a successful student, support provided by the school to help them achieve to the best of their ability. Students also had some fun in the afternoon session. Our new Year 12s were issued with the assessment policy and schedule for HSC courses. The first assessment tasks start in week 6 and can I remind parents that the work from Term 4 and assessment tasks contribute to the final HSC mark. Many parents seem surprised to learn that Term 4 is actually part of the Year 12 HSC requirements. As I constantly tell students, everything they do counts.

U Turn the Wheel

As we know, cars and young people can be a heady mix. I feel it is our duty as educators to positively influence the wellbeing of students in all domains.

On Wednesday 11 November all Year 12 students will be involved in the road safety program "U Turn the Wheel". There will be no regular classes on that day.

Attendance is compulsory and contributes to the mandatory 25 hours Crossroads course. U Turn the Wheel has contributed to a 30% reduction in motor vehicle related casualties in the 17-24 age group since the program began. The cost to the students is \$5 (The real cost is \$10 but half has been subsidized by the P & C and school).

Please ring the school if your son/daughter cannot attend. Arrangements may be made to attend the program when it is presented at another school.

As both a Principal and a parent, "U Turn the Wheel" has my highest recommendation.

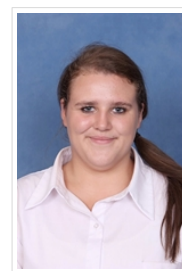

Whooping Cough Alert

The NSW Department of Health has recommended that we publish the following alert in regards to whooping cough:

There is an outbreak of whooping cough (pertussis) in NSW, mainly affecting school-aged children.

Coughing spreads the infection to others nearby. Whooping cough can spread to anyone at home, including younger brothers and sisters. Whooping cough can be especially dangerous for babies.

Whooping cough starts like a cold and progresses to bouts of coughing that can last for many weeks. The infection can occur even in fully-vaccinated children. Older children may just have a cough that is persistent and may be worse at night.

- Children with these symptoms should see a doctor.
- If your doctor diagnoses whooping cough in your school-aged child, please let the school know and keep your child at home until they have taken 5 days of antibiotics. Keep coughing children away from babies.
- Whooping cough vaccines give good protection against infection but immunity fades with time. Check that all your children are up to date with their vaccines, due at 6 weeks, 4 months, 6 months, 4 years and 12 years of age (offered to all Year 7 students through the NSW school-based vaccination program). A booster is also recommended at 18 months of age.

A booster dose of vaccine is also recommended for adults that are in contact with young children, such as school staff and parents. Pregnant women are recommended to have a booster dose during each pregnancy and this is funded by NSW Health. Those who are new parents or carers of babies should consult their general practitioner about appropriate immunisation.
